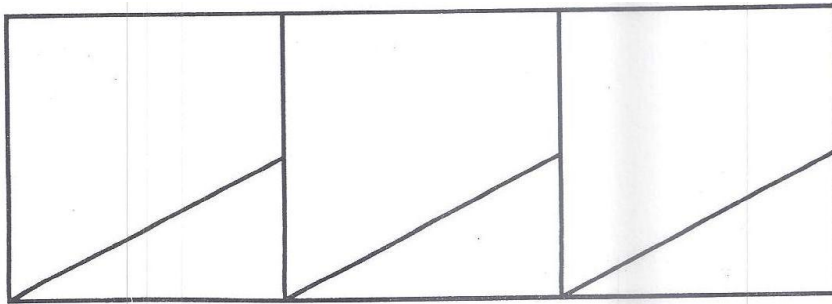

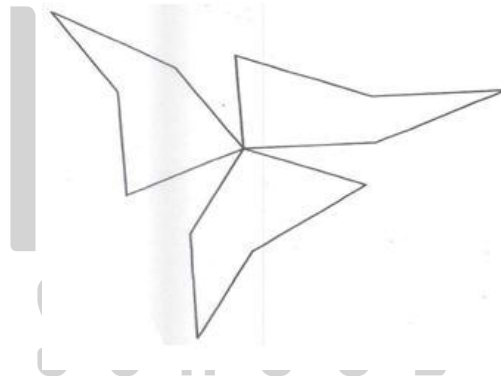
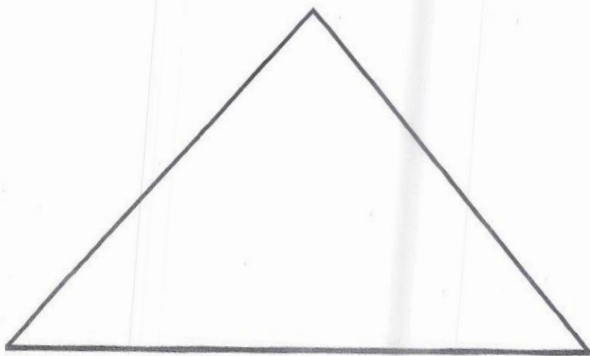
## Maths
