Solution must be shown while converting the units.

2. Measure the angle between your thumb and index finger (first finger) and draw that angle using protractor.

Take poster colour and dip your thumb and index finger in the colour (Stretch your thumb and finger in the opposite direction to form maximum angle) and now put the impression of same on a plain sheet. Now using pencil join the impression to form an angle as shown in the figure attached. Now Measure the (approximate) angle with the help of protractor and draw it on the same sheet below the impression.
